

 $The IB \ Career-related \ Programme \ (CP) \ is \ specifically \ developed \ for \ students \ who \ want to \ engage \ in \ career-related \ learning \ while \ gaining \ transferable \ skills \ in \ applied \ knowledge, \ critical \ thinking, \ communication \ and \ cross-cultural \ engagement.$

CP students undertake a minimum of two IB Diploma Programme (DP) Courses: core studies and a career-related study. Career-related study supports the programme's academic strength and provides practical, real-world approaches to learning. Core studies help students develop the knowledge, skills and attitudes required for lifelong learning.

Award of the CP Certificate

The Certificate of the Career-related Programme of the International Baccalaureate will be awarded subject to satisfactory completion of the following requirements by a candidate:

- The candidate has completed the specified career-related study.
- The candidate has been awarded a grade 3 or more in at least two of the Diploma Programme Courses registered for the Career-related Programme.
- The candidate has been awarded a grade of at least D for the Reflective Project.
- Personal and Professional Skills, Service Learning and Language Development requirements have been met.
- The candidate has not received a penalty for academic misconduct.
- All candidates will receive programme results detailing their level of achievement in the Diploma Programme
 Courses and the Reflective Project along with the status of completion of the Career-related Programme core.
